We serviced 13 families at Thanksgiving with baskets of food including a turkey and all the fixings plus enough food for several more days.

Our pantry is being restocked to prepare for the Christmas baskets which will go to the families on our Angel Tree. These families are from the neighboring schools of Orems , Glen Mar, Martin Boulevard and Victory Villa Elementary Schools. The schools have expressed their sincere thanks in remembering them at this time of year. There has been a great deal of help requested from families in our area and the schools can not keep up with it all.

We were able to begin to restock our pantry with an area food drive held at Orems Elementary school. They delivered 4 boxes of food to the pantry. We are however still in need of certain items. If you are able to help us in anyway it would be greatly appreciated by everyone involved. Here is the list of needed items: jars of gravy, instant potatoes, Tuna, Canned Hams, canned Chicken, Boxed Juices, Saltine Crackers, canned fruits of all kinds. beef stew, biscuit mixes, jello and pudding, sauerkraut, sweet potatoes, jelly and peanut butter.
