Comfort Cases Mission— Help Orems help others for LENT.



As a special mission for Lent we have chosen Comfort Cases. Comfort cases are backpacks filled with

comfort and personal care items for kids entering the foster care system. Typically, children are given a trash bag to pack up their belongings when they are removed from their homes. Comfort Cases believes every child deserves to pack their belongings in a special bag that they can call their very own, to have a cozy new pair of pajamas, a brand new warm blanket, and a new stuffed animal to hug during the traumatic transition into foster care. We have 48 back packs now we need the items to go in the back packs. You can shop for these items or donate the money to the church and our mission committee will shop for you. Place in envelope and write COMFORT CASES.

We need pajamas size 3T to Adult 2X (NO NIGHTGOWNS), soft Throw size blankets, tooth brush, tooth paste, Stuffed animals, books for kids age 2 up to teens age years, Coloring books, crayons, journals, pens and pencils. You can shop by age or just general items, but all goes to help foster children feel more comfortable in an otherwise uncomfortable time in their lives.
