#### **Comfort Cases Mission was our Lent Mission for 2021**.

And what a wonderful response we had from you, Orems congregation for this worthwhile mission!

Comfort cases are backpacks filled with comfort and personal care items for kids entering the foster care system. Typically, children are given a trash bag to pack up their belongings when they are removed from their homes. Can you imagine how that feels? Can there be a better way to help a child in Crisis feel more self worth? Yes, Comfort Cases believes every child deserves to pack their belongings in a special bag that they can call their very own, to have a cozy new pair of pajamas, a brand new warm blanket, and a new stuffed animal to hug during the traumatic transition into foster care.

Orems Church responded very well with items and back packs. Just look at this pile of back packs! We were able to deliver 56 filled backpacks for children age infant to 16 years old. Babies got bibs, wipes,



sippy cups and pacifiers along with their pajamas, blanket, baby book and stuffed toy. Children received Coloring books, learn to read books, along with jammies, blanket and stuffed toy and Teens received deodorant, funshaped pillow or stuffed toy, journals, and Teen books along with their Jammies and blanket. All of the backpacks received a toothbrush, toothpaste

soap, shampoo and lotion.

We were thrilled to have this mission be a success. Thank you to Bob and Pat Collins for delivering the bags to the Comfort Cases Center. #### Why can't we sing in church? And other Covid rules—

Can you remember the last time you sang full voice in worship? It seems impossible that it was over a year ago that our houses of worship closed, and we switched to online worship; and we were advised not to sing in public. Study after study showed that singing is many times more likely to spread the virus than simply talking. And so, we started singing at home as we watched worship, doing our best to participate with body, mind, and spirit. It is no wonder we are all SO ready to get back to our favorite place to sit in our worship space, even as we allow for distancing and singing! Before you make that leap, however, you should consider the following.

What the CDC Says The CDC advises that while churches are opening up, the people should remain masked and not sing until herd immunity has reached at least seventy to eighty-five percent of the population. CDC offers the following general considerations to help churches keep their staff and congregations safe:

- -Wear a mask that completely covers your nose and mouth and Stay at least 6 feet away from others. Avoid large crowds.
- -<u>Wash your hands</u> frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds (or use <u>hand san-itizer</u> containing at least 60% alcohol)
- -<u>Get vaccinated</u> when the vaccine is available to you. <u>Get tested</u> if you have signs or <u>symptoms</u> of COVID-19, or if you think you may have been <u>exposed</u> to someone with COVID-19
- -Limit the sharing of frequently touched objects.
- -Consider a stationary collection box, or electronic methods of collection for regular financial contributions instead of shared collection trays or baskets.
- -If food is offered at any event, consider pre-packaged options and avoid buffet or family-style meals.

The Elite Group "90 and Over"


