A mission meeting was held on June 15th to discuss how best to use our resources in this present economy. The church is not getting the financial support that it has received in other years to continue all of our missions as they have been functioning in the past. We need to adjust what we can give to be more responsible stewards of our resources.

The committee agreed that we need to focus on our immediate community. The first step is to build a partnership with Orems Elementary school to not only provides food and gifts at Christmas, but also address the needs of the teachers and families in other ways. The **Food Pantry, Little Feet** and **Angel Tree** will work closely with the school.

We will also continue to work with the **Streets of Hope** mission to aid the homeless in our area.


